Search for 'OurSchoolsApp' and download the app. Once downloaded, use the search bar within the app and enter our postcode RG9 1SL or Sacred Heart School. Hit the search button.

Once you see our school name displayed, just touch the screen on the school name. Confirm your choice by pressing 'OK'.

As a new academic year begins, now seems as good a time as any to revisit the purpose and guidelines for the school PTA Facebook site.


